Player's Code of Conduct

- I will demonstrate respect for the equipment by only using it in the manner taught by the coach.
- I will demonstrate respect for the facilities by always leaving them in at least as good a state as I found them.
- I will cheer the good play of my teammates and opponents.
- I will offer encouragement to my teammates.
- I support my teammates and coach by staying on the bench during games.

Parent's (Guardian's) Code of Conduct

- I will treat my daughter's coaches, umpires, spectators, teammates and opponents with respect.

- I understand that the coaches and umpires are volunteers and I pledge to never undermine their authority on the field.

- I will offer encouragement to the players on both teams.
- I will give my child's Head Coach as much notice as possible if my child will be unable to attend a game or practice. I understand that even short notice is better than no notice.
- I will support the WGSA's goal of promoting a healthy lifestyle.
- I understand that this is a recreational league, and that the objectives are for my child to gain an understanding of the game, improve her skills and learn about good sportsmanship.
- At all times I will remember that softball is a game, and the first objective is to have fun! I can contribute to this by maintaining a positive attitude in my behaviour and language.
